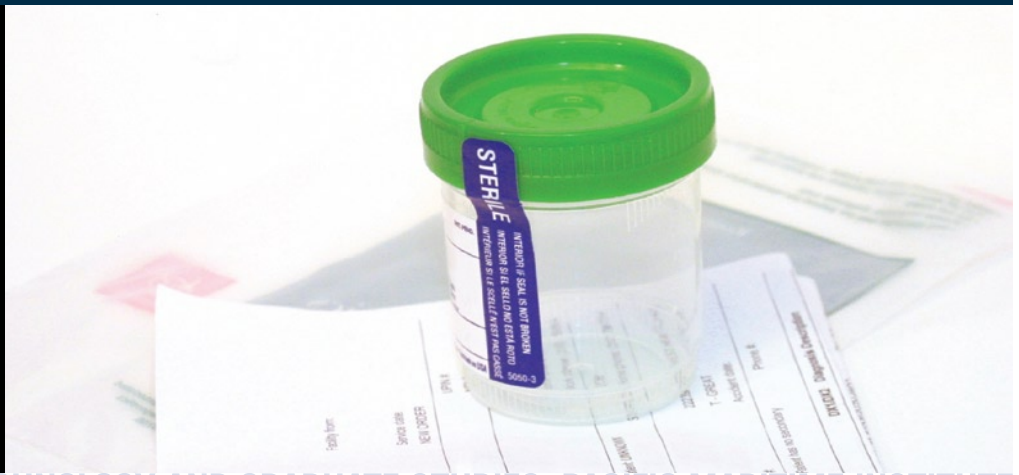

DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION / USCG DRUG AND ALCOHOL TESTING (MED-DOT-DA)

This 1-day (7-hour) course of instruction is designed to provide mariners, designated as urine specimen collectors for drug testing, instruction and proficiency in Department of Transportation (DOT) collection procedures as described in 49 CFR 40. This course also provides instruction in breath testing for alcohol as required in 46 CFR 4. Both elements are accepted by the USCG.

Objective:

A candidate successfully completing this course will be able to:

- Describe the DOT collection procedures, to include the 5 "fatal flaws" in the collection procedure.
- Demonstrate 5 error-free mock collections according to DOT guidelines.
- Demonstrate use of an alcohol breath and saliva testing device for the presence of alcohol in the blood stream.

Pre-Requisite: None
